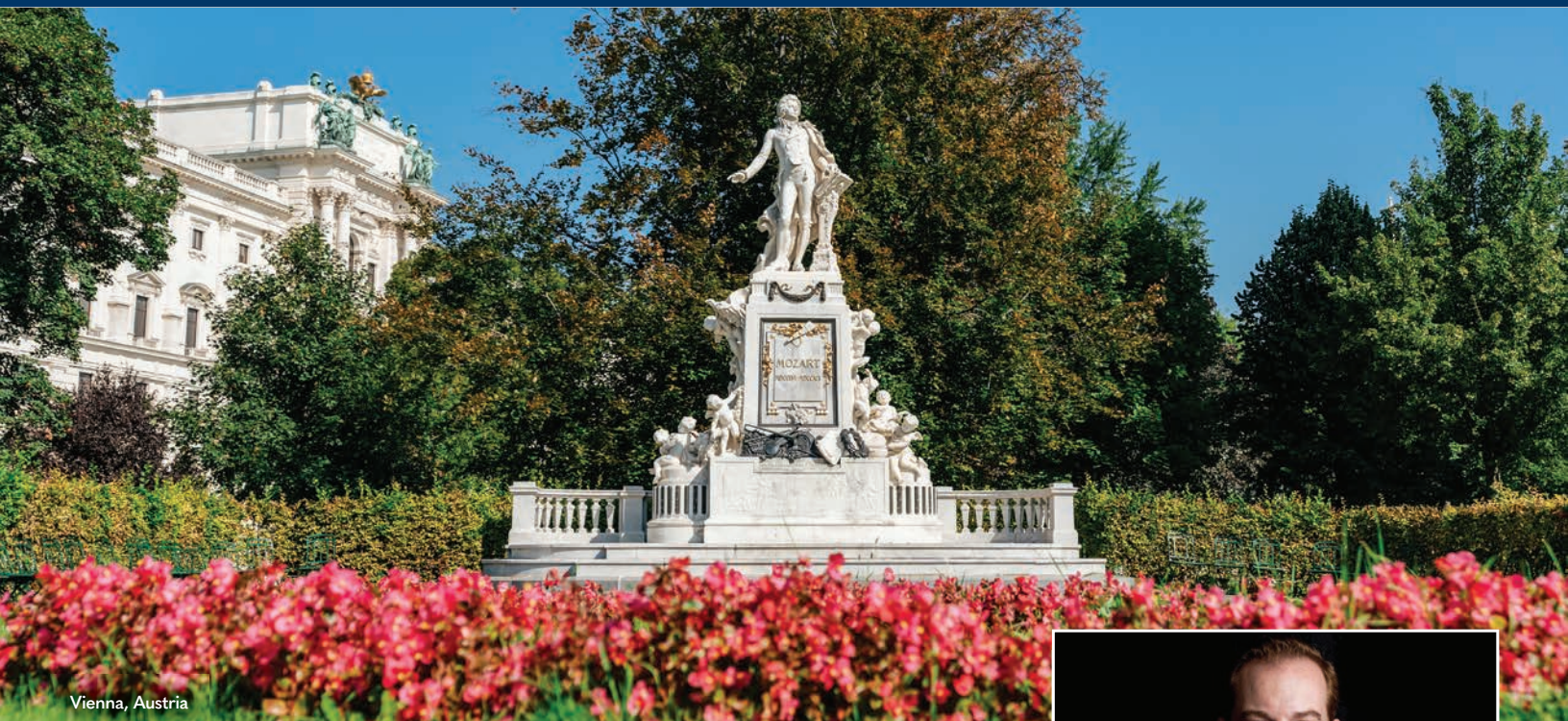

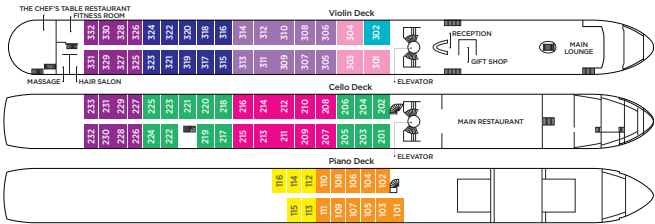

Steven has also collaborated with a wide range of popular artists including Ben Folds, Idina Menzel, Common, Guster, Lyle Lovett and Kenny G. He holds degrees from the University of Michigan and Peabody Institute.
